On this night of a thousand stars, two popular members of the Boston cabaret scene, **Valerie Anastasio** and **Tim Harbold**, will have you swinging on a star with their high energy, light-hearted song stylings.

Blend in the excitement of a juried art exhibition, fascinating garden club competitions, the fragrance of flowers and fresh mulch, festive finger foods and desserts from the *Colonel Blackinton Inn*, *Edible Arrangements*, *Morin's Diner* and *Raymond Norman Cooks*, beer, wine and coffee, and you'll feel like flying to the moon as you play among the stars.



**Valerie Anastasio** and **Tim Harbold** have performed throughout Massachusetts since 1990, blending jazz standards, show tunes, and comic cabaret with their own distinctive musicianship and humor. Their repertoire encompasses a delightful variety of styles, ranging from intimate renditions of Gershwin and Sondheim to zany, crowd-pleasing performances of Barry Manilow's *Copacabana*. The duo has performed on *Ron Della Chiesa's Jazz Songbook* (WGBH Radio), at the *Longy School of Music* (Cambridge, MA) and in *MEA* for the Holidays.

Anastasio and Harbold are frequently featured in the American Classics **Smart Set**, which also includes the duo of Benjamin Sears and Bradford Conner. The Smart Set has created two highly successful shows - *Noel & Cole: Together With Music* and *Fred & Ethel: Great Songs of Astaire & Merman*, which have played to sell out crowds at *Scullers Jazz Club* in Boston and have been recorded on *Oakton Recordings*.

When not performing in cabaret, **Tim Harbold** is the Director of Music in Performance at Wheaton College.
